The pandemic is accelerating the end of cash—and leaving the most vulnerable behind

Since the start of the pandemic, the UK has seen a sharp decline in the use of cash. The volume of cash withdrawn from ATMs has dropped by 60 % during the first national lockdown. More Britons are turning to contactless and digital payments during the Covid-19 crisis, with three quarters believing that the pandemic will reduce their future use of cash.

The use of debit cards as the primary mode of payment overtook cash in 2017—and Covid is accelerating the trend. A Bank of England survey found that in the previous six months, 42 per cent of people had visited a store that did not accept cash, a significant increase from 15 per cent last January. Two main reasons for using less cash: retailers not accepting it (44 per cent) and health concerns about handling it (35 per cent).

However, if the UK isn't careful, it will "sleepwalk" into a cashless society and leave behind the eight million people who still rely on cash, simply because cash is still one of the best ways to budget. The government's guidance on using contactless risks excluding some of the most vulnerable members of society, leaving those dependent on cash even more isolated. The elderly often use cash to simplify their day-to-day budgeting. But they are not the only people who rely on it. Domestic abuse and homelessness charities also say the people they work with often use cash to survive—all the more important as abuse cases rise with lockdowns.

China's aging population will be a 'big shock' to the global supply chain, says economist

An ANZ economist warned on Wednesday that China's aging population will have a big impact on the world as the global supply chain is highly reliant on the world's second-largest economy. China's once-a-decade census released on Tuesday showed the population of the mainland grew to 1.41 billion people as of Nov. 1, 2020. That was the slowest growth rate since the 1950s.

The trend of the old age dependency is going to rise. This is a warning not only for China, but also across the whole world, as China is the core of the supply chain. Over the next few years, China will be losing 70 million of its workforce, so this is a big shock to the global supply chain. Moreover, another possible impact would be on financial markets, as China's high savings rate has been supporting global markets. China has one of the world's highest savings rates among individuals. Many retail investors are investing their extra cash or the money is being held in pension funds.

Experts have said that China's aging problem goes beyond its one-child policy and that other changes are needed to boost growth. China should continue to sustain growth through technological development, go for high tech, go for transformation of the whole supply chain, in order to support the economic growth on a sustainable basis.
